Denominational Views

#1 - Allegorical View -

It's a book of symbols and types and little, if anything, is real or to happen at all. -

#2 - Historical View -

It's all done, fulfilled, it's not a futuristic book. What it speaks of is that of things that already happened in the past.

#3 - Correct View, The Literal View -

Understanding that the events are of the future. That from chapter One to Chapter Four deals with the Revelation of Jesus Christ, His Church in the Earth and from Chapter 4:1 to the End are Futuristic Events

Which is "The" - Revelation of Jesus Christ, The Book of Revelation Being the Final Act to the Grand Revelation!

Psalm 40:7-8

Then I said, "Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me. :8 I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart."

Hebrews 10:7

Then I said, "Behold, I have come— In the volume of the book it is written of Me— To do Your will, O God.' "

The Second of those Two very Important Things is

The (A) Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave ...

"which God gave..." This is God the Father

It's the Father's desire that the world be introduced to Jesus Christ His Son

John 3:34-35

For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure unto Him. :35 The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

John 5:20-24

For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel. :21 For as the Father raises the dead and gives life to them, even so the Son gives life to whom He will. :22 For the Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son, :23 that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him. :24 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.

John 5:37

And the Father Himself, who sent Me,

John 6:38-40

For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. :39 This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. :40 And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."

Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works.

He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me.

v. 1: A Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him

John 14:6-7

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.: 7 "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."

John 8:18-19

I am One who bears witness of Myself, and the Father who sent Me bears witness of Me." Then they said to Him, "Where is Your Father?" ¶ Jesus answered, "You know neither Me nor My Father. If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also."

c.) It's The Will of Heaven – that Jesus be known

v. 1: Which God gave Him (Jesus) to show His servants — things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified it by **His angel**

It's the Angels' desire that we would see Jesus

The Heavenly, Angelic Hosts Worship

Revelation 4:8

The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is to come!"

(who is doing the worshipping? / who is being worshipped?)

Isaiah 6:1-4

...I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the glory of His *robe* filled the temple. :2 Above throne stood seraphim, angels; each one had six wings: with two wings he covered over his face, with two wings he covered over his feet, and with the remaining two wings he flew. :3 And each one cried to the other and said: "Holy, holy, holy *is* the LORD of hosts; The whole earth *is* full of His glory!" :4 And the beams of the door were shaken by the voice of them who cried out...

The Heavenly, Angelic Hosts Worship

1 Timothy 3:16

And without controversy (undisputed truth / failing arguments) great is the mystery of godliness: God was **unveiled** publicly in the flesh, **justified** in the Spirit, **seen** of angels, **preached** unto the Gentiles, **believed** on in the world, **received** up into glory.

The Angel's Gawked

Angel's aren't easily impressed - they've seen a lot in their lifetime

Luke 2:8-15

Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. :9 And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. :10 Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. :11 For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. :12 And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger." :13 And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: :14 "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!" :15 So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, "Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us."

The (a) Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Jesus Christ to show His servants. (Who are His Servants?) —things which must shortly take place And He sent and signified it by His angel to His servant John.

To His Servant John,

John, Author of the Gospel of John This John, Author of 1,2,3 Epistles of John And Eyewitness, Historian of the Book of Revelation

It's What The Apostle John was Saying

1 John 1:1-3

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning the Word of life—:2 the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us—:3 that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. – and all of God's people said...

John 1:1-2,14

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. :2 He was in the beginning with God...:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Revelation 1:9

I, John, both your brother and companion in the tribulation and kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was on the island that is called Patmos for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Imprisoned on Patmos in the Greek Isles of the Mediterranean

Was the only apostle to die of old age. After being persecuted, beaten, and boiled alive in a vat of oil – John was miraculously kept by God and banished to exile...

John Confesses

I, John... was on the island that is called Patmos

Because #1 - for **the word** of God and Because #2 - for **the testimony** of Jesus Christ.

That Fact is that after 2,000 years you're sitting here holding a Bible in your lap!

A Revelation of Jesus Christ by the Book

a.) The Old Testament Confirmation

v. 2: John - who bore witness to the word of God,

John is Saying - I've put the historical record of the old testament on trial. I have pursued every clue, Every lead, I have interviewed others and I have seen with my own eyes and I have heard with my own ears what the ancient scriptures have foretold about Jesus. – it's true!

A Revelation of Jesus Christ by the Book

b.) The New Testament Confirmation

v. 2: ...to His servant John; who bore witness to the word of God, and to the testimony of Jesus Christ, to all things that he saw...

JOHN IS SAYING HERE;

That he placed everything that Jesus said and did on trial.

That he pursued Every clue, Every Lead, he checked out everything he saw and heard and has concluded, that Jesus is the Christ, exactly the One who He said He was!

c.) The Harmony of the Scriptures

(O.T. & N. T.)

Isaiah 48:12

"Listen to Me, O Jacob, and Israel, My called: I am He, I am the First, I am also the Last.

Isaiah 44:6

"Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: `I am the First and I am the Last; besides Me there is no God.
