The Background to the Parable:

This parable was one of many teachings given by Jesus on the Tuesday after Palm Sunday during passion week leading up to His **(1) crucifixion, (2) death, (3) burial, (4) resurrection** and **(5) His ascension.**

This puts an added urgency to what Jesus was saying. The **topics**, the **context** and the **timing** of both this week in History and the Events unfolding in Jerusalem - made this Parable all the more Powerful.

Let's Turn to Matthew 23:37-24:34

The Disciples Were Listening Well to Chapter 23 – Which Prompted an Awesome Series of Questions and Answers

Matthew 24:1-2

Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. **2** And Jesus said to them, **"Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down."**

Luke 21:5-6

Then, as some spoke of the temple, how it was adorned with beautiful stones and donations, He said,
6 “*These things which you see—the days will come in which not one stone shall be left upon another
that shall not be thrown down.*”

Matthew 24:3-4

:3 Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, “Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?” :4 And Jesus answered and said to them: “*Take heed that no one deceives you.*”

Jesus sets the Context for us, using the Bible—
in **Matthew 24:15** Jesus Looks Back to Daniel’s Prophecy.
